Lesson {15 minutes}

Background:

God created everything to be good, but people decided to rebel against God. When we sin, it separated us from God. For a long time, there were people who still followed God... but eventually everyone except one family was wicked.

. Main Idea:

Our behavior makes a big difference (Genesis 6:5-22; 7).

Page 30-34 in Action Bible 3 Points:

- 1. Because of the wickedness of everyone in the world, God made a plan to start over with Noah and his family (Genesis 6:5-12).
- 2. God gave Noah specific instructions to build an ark to save him, his family, and all the animals from the flood that He would send (Genesis 6:13-21).
- 3. Noah obeyed God, and once everyone was in the ark, it rained for forty days and forty nights (Genesis 6:22-7:24).

Connections to Make:

<u>Connection to Jesus</u> - Just as God invited everyone who followed Him to enter through the doors of the ark, so Jesus invites us all to follow Him.

<u>Connection to OT</u> - When God created the world, He said it was good. Now the rebellion and wickedness of the human heart introduced in Genesis 3 has become the reputation of humanity.

<u>Connection to us</u> - Our behaviors matter to God! When we are followers of Jesus, it shows in our actions. *Object Lesson:*

Candy Bars with bites out of them: Tell the kids you just couldn't help yourself, and you took a bite out of each of the candy bars... but you're sure that didn't make too much of a difference. Our actions make a difference!



Step 1 - Ask Gathering Question & Grade-Level Questions
Step 2 - Listen to kids recite last week's memory verse (printed at bottom of this page)
Step 3 - Ask kids for prayer requests and pray with them
Step 4 - If you have extra time, do the Memory Verse Work

Gathering Question: Have you ever been on a boat? What was it like?

Grades K & 1

Recap:

Hand out Noah Cards to kids. Have each child tell you what they remember about the picture they receive.

Ask:

Why did God chose Noah to build the ark? (Genesis 6:8-9)

Show kids a Behavior Chart, and let them move clips on the behavior chart for how they think each person was behaving according to God:

Noah; Sham; Ham; Japheth; Noah's neighbors

Grades 2 & 3

Recap:

Toss a beach ball with questions around the circle. Whichever question is facing each child is the one that child answers about Noah.

Ask:

How big was the ark? (Genesis 6:15)

Who built the ark for God? (Genesis 6:8-10)

Talk About:

What is one thing you did yesterday? What kind of a difference did that action make? What is one thing you can do this week that will make a positive difference for someone?

Grades 4 & 5

Recap:

Toss a beach ball with questions around the circle. Whichever question is facing each child is the one that child answers about Noah.

Ask:

Why did God chose Noah to build the ark? (Genesis 6:8-9)

Talk About:

What do you think it was like for Noah while he was building the ark?

This Week's Memory Verse: "But Noah found favor in the eyes of the Lord." Genesis 6:8


Memory Verse Work:

Center #2 Blindfolded Squirt Tag
